Officers and Their Election

135	ARTICLE VI: OFFICERS AND THEIR ELECTION

137	Section 1. The officers of this PTA/PTSA shall consist of:
138	 one (1) president or two (2) individual co-presidents.

140	 4 vice president(s) or individual co-vice presidents *(designate officer's responsibilities and titles, if applicable)

143	 Lsecretary(ies) *(designate officer's responsibilities and titles, if applicable); and

146	 a treasurer. (Georgia PTA does not approve co-treasurers).

148	Please note: The Parliamentarian is not elected but is appointed by the President. #Section 2. Each individual officer and individual co-officers shall have a vote.
149 150	Section 3. Officers shall be elected in the month of April
150	#Section 4. The vote shall be conducted by ballot. When there is but one candidate for an office, the ballot for that office may be
152	dispensed with and election held by voice vote. A majority vote shall be required for election.
153	#Section 5. The following provisions shall govern the qualifications and eligibility of individuals to be officers of this PTA/PTSA:
154	a. Each officer shall be a member of this local PTA/PTSA.
155	b. No officer may be eligible to serve more than two consecutive terms in the same office.
156	c. A person who has served in an office for more than one half of a full term shall be deemed to have served a full term
157	in such office; and
158	d. No member shall serve as a council president while serving as a local unit president.
159	Section 6. Officers shall assume their official duties following the close of the school year and serve for a term of
160	Lyear(s) or until their successor is elected.
161	#Section 7. A vacancy occurring in any office shall be filled for the unexpired term by a person elected by a majority vote of the
162	Board of Directors notice of such election having been given to the Board of Directors. In case a vacancy occurs in the office of
163	president, the first vice-president shall serve notice of the election.
164	Section 8. There shall be a nominating committee composed of 5 members (must be an uneven number) and
165	2 alternates who shall be elected by this local PTA/PTSA at a regular general membership meeting at least one
166 167	month prior to the election of officers, as outlined in Article VI, Section 3. a. All members of the nominating committee shall be a member of this PTA/PTSA.
168	b. The committee shall elect its own chair.
169	c. The nominating committee shall nominate an eligible person for each office to be filled and report its nominees at
170	the regular general membership meeting in April at which time additional nominations may be made from
171	the floor. (Note: Must be the same month in #ARTICLE VI: OFFICERS AND THEIR ELECTION. Section 3)
172	d. Only those individuals who are current members of this local PTA/PTSA and who have signified their consent to
173	serve if elected shall be nominated for, or elected to, such office.
174	e. The president is not eligible for election to the nominating committee.
175	f. The principal is eligible to serve if elected.
176	#Section 9. The slate of proposed officers shall be posted in the school office at least ten (10) days prior to the election meeting.




